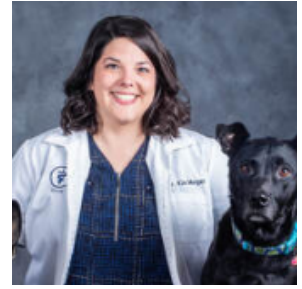

ADDISON'S DISEASE The Great Pretender

Sometimes, the presentation of fairly benign symptoms can prove to be more than meets the eye. This is typically the case with Addison's Disease.

Also known as hypoadrenocorticism, this syndrome affects the endocrine system causing acute (in severe cases) and intermittent (in mild cases) vomiting, lethargy and inappetence.

The underlying processes of this disease involve the adrenal glands, the pituitary gland, or be immune-mediated in nature. When chemical signals from these systems are unbalanced, naturally occurring steroids are depleted. These are integral in regulating potassium and sodium for proper muscle function, immunity and metabolism.

Lifelong treatment for Addison's Disease is required, but long term outcomes are excellent with consistent medication and careful attention!
