We rely on our canine companions when disaster strikes. Search dogs, arson detectors, and guide dogs are only some of the ways that our brave and loyal pets help us when in need. However, what if *they* are the ones that need help?

Natural disasters occur worldwide every day and readiness to care for your pets during a crisis is vital.

Tornadoes, earthquakes, and flooding cause major and life altering damages, but consider if the electrical grid went down – would you be prepared to care for your pet for days at a time?

Many people enjoy outdoor adventures and vacations with their pets – would you be able to handle an injury if you were off the beaten path?

The simplest way to start is a first aid kit in a watertight container, extra unopened bags of food, and a generous amount of clean water. During an emergent situation, food and water are typically the first items to sell out. Purchasing these items in advance will alleviate any supply or transportation issues that may arise.

Although it may seem natural to think your pet will stay with you in an emergency, many pets will panic and run away. Keep an emergency leash or carrier for each of your pets in an easily accessible area to prevent separation or possible loss of your beloved family member.

Additionally, a first aid booklet can be an invaluable tool to pack in your pets survival kit. Although many books are available online, a paperback booklet is best as phone and internet service may be unavailable in a crisis.
